IBEW Local 9 & MSECA Apprenticeship Opportunities

I.B.E.W Local 9 and the Middle States Electrical Contractors Association requirements for the Outdoor Electrical Worker/Line Maintainer Apprenticeship Program.

In order to apply, all applicants must provide the following documentation.

- A valid CDL-A **driver's license** with air brake endorsement.
- Original Social Security Card
- Resume
- Original high school diploma, G.E.D. or original transcript in a sealed envelope from the educational institution. Absolutely no copies will be accepted
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to IBEW Local 9 Apprenticeship Fund

We strongly encourage qualified women and minorities to apply.

I.B.E.W Local 9 and the Middle States Electrical Association will not discriminate against apprenticeship applicants or apprentices based on race, color, religion, national origins, sex (including pregnancy and gender identity), sexual orientation, genetic information, or because they are an individual with a disability or a person 40 years old or older.
