To apply, all applicants must appear in person and bring 2 copies of the following documentation, except transcripts

- A valid CDL-A driver's license with air brake endorsement or CDL-A permit with medical card **(medical cards are given through Concentra or your own doctor)**
- Original Social Security Card
- Resume
- Original high school diploma, G.E.D. **or original transcript in a sealed envelope from the educational institution. Absolutely no copies will be accepted of this document.**
- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Cashier's check or money order in the amount of \$25.00 made payable to IBEW Local 9 Apprenticeship Fund
- You must have all documents to apply.
- An aptitude test date will be given to you upon completion of application.
- Study guides will be available for \$15 check or money order only.
